
Steps

- 1. Before removing current visor; review all hardware and visor prior to installation.
- 2. Put two visor halves together with center bracket installed between both halves (see diagram on reverse). Do not fully tighten as adjustments will be needed.
- 3. Hold up visor and mark 2nd mounting hole at ear location (to drill).
- 4. Remove visor, drill ½" hole at marked location at ears, and remove 2 bolts on center windshield post that match holes in center bracket. Bolts removed will be used for remounting.
- 5. Press the rivnuts into ½" holes at visor ends (into cab).
- To install the center bracket, mount visor onto truck without tightening bolts on ear flaps. You might need another person to assist with the mounting of visor mounted on center of window trim.
- 7. Reinstall bolts in center visor bracket through windshield post.
- 8, Tighten all bolts and remove that PVC coating from visor.
- 9. Wipe away finger prints with window cleaner.


